

THE REGULATION

1. Upon arrival, the campers must give their identity documents for the registration. Entry in the campsite is authorized only with permission of the management. Guests must communicate their arrival and departure, and also possible changes in the equipment
2. The management reserves the right (no exception) not to accept guests who are unwelcome for previous incorrect actions
3. Under-age guests are allowed only if accompanied by their parents or other adult relatives, who are responsible for their behaviour. Children must be taken to the lavatories and watched over by their parents when using the campsite facilities. In regard to this, the management declines all responsibility
4. The sites will always be assigned by the management, whose directions all campers must follow. Campers may place in the site only what is expressly allowed. It is forbidden to move from the assigned place
5. During the mid and high season it is strictly forbidden to leave tents or caravans vacant for more than two days, during which the tariffs for the whole group will be applied. In that case, the management will ask the defaulters to remove their tent or caravan
6. Sites must be vacated by 1.00 p.m. If these rules are not followed, the amount for another day will be charged
7. -
8. Cars must be parked in the places suggested by the management, who could ask the guests to move their car to another place, if necessary
9. Inside the campsite cars must circulate at manø walking.
10. During the quiet hours from 11.00 p.m. until 8.00 a.m. and from 1.30 p.m. until 3.30 p.m. campers must keep the noise level at the lowest. During the entire day troublesome noises are forbidden; radio and television are allowed only if kept at low volume. The front gate is closed from 11.00 p.m. until 7.00 a.m.
The barrier at the entrance is likewise lowered from 1.30 p.m. until 3.30 p.m. During these hours it is forbidden to circulate with vehicles inside the campsite; motorcycles and mopeds can circulate only if led by hand
11. Guests are responsible of their personal belongings. The management is not responsible for damages caused by falling trees or branches
12. Sanitary blocks must be cleaned after use. Hot showers are free and last about 4 minutes; also, guests are kindly requested not to waste water
13. Guests must respect the vegetation, and the hygiene and cleanliness of the campsite. Paper, plastic, glass and rubbish must be thrown in the special containers. Possible damages caused to the campsite facilities or anything else will be charged to the liable persons
14. Connection to the electric sockets must be requested beforehand to the management. It is compulsory to use grounding cables according to standard regulations. Every socket is provided with a safety device and a current limiting device, which allows a supply of no more than 2 Amperes (about 440 Watt). During the low seasons 6 Amp. are available
15. It is unauthorized to wash cars and or any other equipment (tends, boats) inside the campsite
16. Clothes and behaviour must always be appropriate and never give cause for concern
17. It is strictly forbidden to light fires, whereas it is allowed to use the barbecues at the camperø our responsibility. Campers will place the barbecue as not to cause damage

to the vegetation. It is not allowed to throw ashes on the ground; before they are disposed of, they must be put out in order to avoid fires

18. It is unauthorized use the campsite anti-fire equipment except in case of emergency
19. Campers make use of the campsite facilities, playing area and anything else at their own risk and danger

OCCASIONAL GUESTS

20. Guests and visitors who do not stay in the campsite overnight are considered occasional guests
21. Guests and visitors are allowed only with the permission of the management. Those who are allowed must leave their identity document and must pay the regular daily rate if they stay for more than 1 hour
22. Occasional guests may enter the campsite until 8.00 p.m.; entry after this time is not allowed. They may stay in the campsite only until 11.00 p.m.
23. Parking of visitors cars inside the campsite is allowed only with the permission of the management, depending on available space

REGULATION FOR DOG OWNERS

24. Dogs are allowed inside the campsite only during the low season period (from 1st September until 30th June) with the permission of the management and under the following provisions:
25. They are muzzled and kept inside the owner's site. Dogs are not allowed on the beach (as the regional law provides)
26. The owner can provide vaccination certificates, if requested
27. They do not disturb other guests
28. They are taken outside the tourist complex for their physical needs
29. They are always kept on a leash
30. Dog owners are always responsible for any damage caused by their animals to people or things

Anyone entering this campsite must accept the above-stated regulations and respectfully its rules and every possible supplement or further rule, which the management will think proper to issue for improved management of the campsite
